2008 Undergraduate Scholarship Application

The CFEA Scholarship Program was established in May 2005 to provide financial support to undergraduate members of CFEA member organizations pursuing degrees in communications-related fields.

Applicants must:

- Be juniors or seniors who will be enrolled as undergraduates in the fall of 2008.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Have a letter of recommendation sent directly by the person making the recommendation.
- Belong to a CFEA member organization

Students who are participating in study abroad or internship programs during the fall semester are eligible to receive scholarship funds for the spring 2009 semester. Scholarship funds will only be distributed to students enrolled in undergraduate coursework.

Successful applicants will be notified by the Scholarship Committee by June 15, 2008. The minimum scholarship amount will be \$500. The number of recipients will vary based on qualification and available resources. Funds will be distributed directly to scholarship recipients prior to the start of the fall quarter/semester, based on validation of enrollment.
